



How do I become a Partner?

Complete and submit an **application** found on our **website**. Laura Imschweiler will respond to each applicant to confirm partnership.



What is the cost of each partnership level?

EXECUTIVE (Exclusive)	\$2,500
ASSOCIATE (Limited)	\$1,000

What is the duration of a partnership?

A partnership will be an **annual commitment**, concluding 365 days from the date that it begins. Applications will be accepted until February 28 of each year.
